PROCEDURAL ORDER

On September 5, 2025, CG Apache County Wind LLC and CG Apache County Solar LLC ("Applicants") filed an Application for a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility ("Certificate") in the above captioned matter with Docket Control of the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission"). A copy of the Application was transmitted to Adam Stafford, designee of the Attorney General of Arizona, Kristin Mayes, as Chairman ("Chairman") and Presiding Officer of the Arizona Power Plant and Transmission Line Siting Committee ("Committee").

Pursuant to notice given as provided by law, the Committee held public hearings on October 20 through October 23, 2025, in Pinetop, Arizona, in conformance with the requirements of Arizona Revised Statutes ("A.R.S.") §§ 40-360, et seq., for the purpose of receiving evidence and deliberating on the Application in the above-captioned case.

At the conclusion of the hearing, the Committee, after considering the (i) Application, (ii) evidence, testimony, and exhibits presented by the Applicants, (iii) limited appearance statements, and (iv) comments of the public, and being advised of the legal

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27 28 requirements of A.R.S. §§ 40-360 through 40-360.13, upon motion duly made and seconded, voted 8 to 2 to grant the Applicants, their successors and assigns, a Certificate for construction of the Lava Run Interconnection Project. On October 30, 2025, the Chairman filed the Certificate with Docket Control of the Commission.

At its Open Meeting on December 3, 2025, the Commission considered and discussed the Certificate issued by the Committee and voted to send the matter back to the Committee for the taking of additional evidence. On December 10, 2025, the Commission issued Decision No. 81582, which found and concluded:

- 1. The matter is remanded for consideration of additional evidence on county and municipal land use concerns, land use impacts in Apache County in the area of jurisdiction, and that such evidence can be accorded proper weight in the balancing required by A.R.S. § 40-360.07(B).
- 2. Additional evidence about land use plans in the affected area of jurisdiction, and any other matter of public concern, is necessary in balancing the need for an adequate, economical, and reliable supply of electric power against the impact on the area of jurisdiction.
- 3. This remand does not require the Applicant to resubmit an application, nor does it require the Committee to revisit the matter de novo. The remand is focused on additional public, county and municipal input for the record.

IT IS ORDERED that the Applicant and all potential parties shall meet with the Chairman for a procedural conference on December 19, 2025, beginning at 10:30 a.m. via Zoom at:
